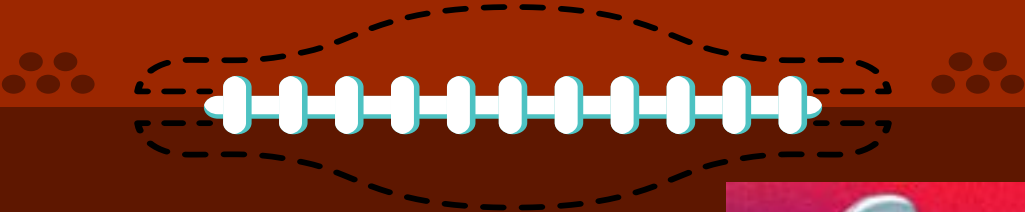


Andy Bullock
