MEMORANDUM

Subject: Authorization, Check Processing, and Reimbursement Procedures

Date: March 4, 2026

This memorandum serves as a reminder of our financial authorization and reimbursement procedures. We appreciate everyone's continued hard work, commitment, and the excellent results you help achieve.

Contract Authorized Signatures

The Potentate is the sole authorized signer for all contracts. He will coordinate directly with Amy or myself regarding any checks that need to be issued and signed, including required due dates.

Check Processing

Checks are written every other week and will be available to print once they have received full approval. All issued checks require two signatures, and one of those signatures must be the Treasurer.

Reimbursement Approvals

Reimbursements may require approval from multiple parties to ensure proper oversight and compliance. The required approvals include:

1. The Chairman of the Event — Correctness
2. The Potentate — Budget oversight
3. The Accounting Department — Compliance and Administrative

To maintain accurate records and ensure timely expense reporting, receipts for reimbursements must be submitted to the office within 15 days following the event or pilgrimage. This policy helps ensure that reimbursements are recorded in the appropriate month in which they occur.

These steps help maintain transparency, accuracy, and adherence to our financial procedures.

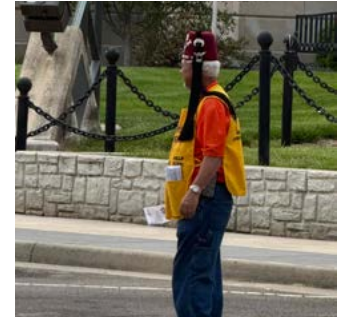

SHARE YOUR FRATERNAL PRIDE ON JUNE 6

On June 6, 1876, the Imperial Council, the original governing body of the Shriners fraternity, was founded. To honor this important milestone in our history, Shriners International has declared June 6 as Shriners International Awareness Day. On this day, nobles everywhere are encouraged to celebrate our great fraternity and raise awareness of its importance in their communities.

The leadership of Shriners International is mindful that June 6 is also honored as D-Day, the day in 1944 when Allied forces landed on the beach in Normandy to begin the invasion of northern France. While Shriners International certainly honors the valor and courage of everyone who served on D-Day, many historic events happen on a single day; and June 6 also holds a separate, special meaning for our fraternity.

A TIME TO HONOR AND CELEBRATE OUR RICH HERITAGE

On June 6, Shriners International asks all nobles to publicly display their pride in their fraternity by wearing a fez (when appropriate), hat, shirt, lapel pin, or other item with the Shriners International logo.

In addition to wearing Shriner apparel, Shriners International also encourages all temples and Shrine clubs to organize special events at their temples and in their communities to honor our fraternity's incredible history and achievements, and invite others to participate, as well.

Hadi UCO Requirements for Conducting a Raffle

1. Must get Fund Raising Activity Approval Form signed by the Potentate before proceeding with a Raffle. Form provided in Hadi Office or Hadi Website (hadishrine.org).
2. Must turn in gaming rules for your Raffle to the office. Rules must get approval before proceeding with the raffle. Contact Hadi Office for example rules. Make necessary changes to meet your raffle.
3. Must get Raffle Ticket approved before selling tickets. Below is an example ticket. Highlighted items must be on the ticket. The "To Claim Prize Contact" can be the UCO contact info or Hadi Office. Tickets should be sequentially numbered for security and recording sales. The Ref # changes every year, call office for current number.
4. All Monies received must be turned into the Hadi office. A check of equal amount will then be issued back to the UCO.
5. All sold and unsold tickets must be turned into the Hadi office.
6. A list of all UCO members that sold tickets must be turned into the office.

****The above procedures must be followed in order for the office to complete a required Event Summary Report and to be in compliance with Indiana Gaming laws.****
